

What Price Road Safety?

We are very concerned that Conservative Councillors are seeking to stop a road safety scheme along Hillmorton Road and are putting money before road injuries.

The fact is that Warwickshire's Safety Engineering Casualty Reduction unit has a policy to help prioritise road safety schemes. The policy they use is a minimum of 6 injury accidents in the last 3 years over a 1-kilometre stretch of road. There have been 12 along Hillmorton Road that makes it high priority. The unit is also proposing to extend the scheme to incorporate the 5 injury accidents that have occurred along High Street Hillmorton with the introduction of vehicle-activated signs. All the emergency services have been consulted and no objections were received. The Safety

Engineering Team works in partnership with the police and values their views highly.

The fact is that value for money is also taken into account and a commitment to the taxpayer to reduce casualties. Accidents cost the taxpayer money, i.e. cost of emergency services attending the scene, hospital treatment, street repairs, time off work etc. For 1 injury accident alone the average cost is £89,820. For a fatal accident this could be a seven-figure cost. As the area where the majority of the accidents will be treated by this scheme, there will be a huge saving made by this scheme giving a good return on the £80,000 spent and if not spent here will go elsewhere in the County.

We will continue our campaign for a safer A428 all the way to the county boundary. Tell us what you think by sending us your comments.

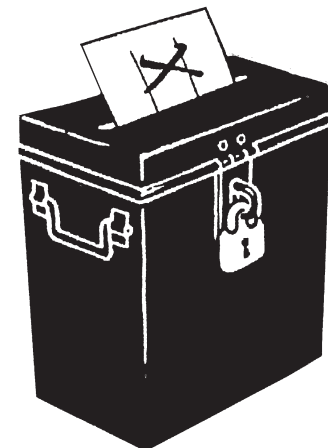
